The United Nations (K4)

This tower of power is the ultimate in burgers in both size and taste. It combines over 32 oz. of fresh ground American Kobe beef, fresh ground bison, and 100% ground sirloin into a quadruple decker mountain of burger. It is generously topped with applewood smoked bacon, Canadian bacon, swiss, cheddar and gouda cheese. It is further garnished with sauteed mushrooms, sauteed onions, vine ripened tomato, lettuce, tomato, mayo, mustard, ketchup and seasoned with our own Summit blend and served on a freshly baked poppy seed bun with a side of fries and a pickle



Thai Burger

This specialty burger begins with an 8 oz. 100% ground sirloin beef patty poached in a soy ginger glaze and topped with sauteed red & green peppers, spicy Asian cole slaw, swiss cheese, wasabi mayo, Thai peanut dressing, sesame seeds and grilled shrimp. Cooking With Beer!

Amber Cayenne-Citrus Marinade for Beef or Lamb

Ingredients:

- 2 12 oz. bottles amber ale
- 1 tablespoon red wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons fresh orange juice
- 1 teaspoon grated orange zest
- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 1 tablespoon grated horseradish
- 1/2 cup minced onion
- 2 tablespoons minced garlic
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon cayenne pepper (or more, to taste)

Directions

Mix all ingredients together in a blender, pureeing until onions and garlic are liquified. Reserve one cup for basting, and use remainder as a marinade for beef or lamb. Use a shoulder or leg cut. Marinate meat for at least two hours for best flavor.

This Week in History - 9/7

Sept 7th in 1813, the US gets its nickname, Uncle Sam. The name is linked to Samuel Wilson, a meat packer from Troy, NY, who supplied barrels of beef to the US Army during the War of 1812. Wilson (1766-1854) stamped the barrels with "U.S." for United States, but soldiers began referring to the grub as "Uncle Sam's." The newspaper picked up on the story and Uncle Sam eventually gained widespread acceptance as the US Government nickname.

Sept 8th in 1974, in a controversial executive action, Pres. Gerald Ford pardons his disgraced predecessor Richard Nixon for any crimes he may have committed or participated in while in office. Ford later defended this action before the House Judiciary Committee, explaining that he wanted to end the national divisions created by the Watergate scandal.

Sept 10th in 1897, a 25-year-old London taxi driver named George Smith becomes the first person ever arrested for drunk driving after slamming his cab into a building. In the US, the first laws against operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol went into effect in New York in 1910.

Sept 11, 2001 At 8:45 a.m. on a clear Tuesday morning, an American Airlines Boeing 767 loaded with 20,000 gallons of jet fuel crashes into the north tower of the World Trade Center (WTC) in NYC. Then, 18 minutes after the first plane hit, a second Boeing 767--United Airlines Flight 175--appeared out of the sky, turned sharply toward the WTC, and sliced into the south tower at about the 60th floor. AA Flight 77 circled over downtown Washington and slammed into the west side of the Pentagon military headquarters at 9:45. Jet fuel from the Boeing 757 caused a devastating inferno that led to a structural collapse of a portion of the giant concrete building. Meanwhile, a fourth California-bound plane--United Flight 93--was hijacked about 40 minutes after leaving Newark International Airport in New Jersey later crashing in a rural field in western Pennsylvania at 10:10 a.m. Its intended target is not known, but theories include the White House, the U.S. Capitol, the Camp David presidential retreat in Maryland, or one of several nuclear power plants along the eastern seaboard.
