Oktoberfest 2009

We know it's still September but the official Oktoberfest celebration in Munich, Germany has already begun! Those in Munich celebrate Oktoberfest 2009 from September 19 – October 4 this year.



Some of you may be unfamiliar with the history behind the many Oktoberfest celebrations that take place all over the world. We'd like to think that it is actually a good reason to drink great beer, eat pretzels and strudel and just make merry!

The first Oktoberfest celebration took place in Munich on October 18, 1810 in honor of the marriage of Crown Prince Ludwig (who later became King Ludwig I) and Princess Therese. The grounds where the festival take place are called Theresienwiese (meaning the field or meadow of Therese) and is often referred to as "Wiesn" for short.

Our idea of Oktoberfest is born not out of the marriage of a prince and princess but rather out of the marriage of great food and great beer! We celebrate our Oktoberfest every year during the

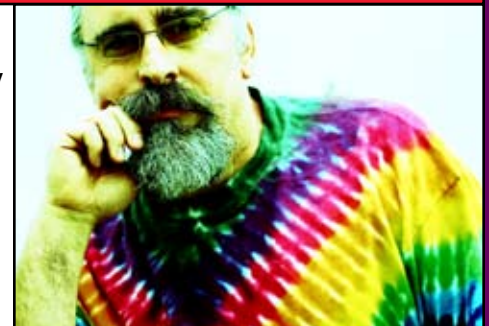

Cooking With Beer!

Grilled Zucchini with Lemon & Porter with Pasta

Ingredients:

Zest of one half lemon, grated
2 large cloves garlic, pressed
1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
1 tablespoon olive oil
4 ounces porter
6-10 slices thick-cut zucchini
1 can (15 ounces) white beans, drained and rinsed
2 roasted red peppers, diced
12 to 14 ounces dried fusilli or cavatappi pasta
1 1/2 cups coarsely chopped fresh flat leaf parsley
1/4 cup coarsely chopped fresh sage
3 tablespoons coarsely chopped fresh rosemary
Kosher salt and fresh ground pepper to taste
Grated Romano cheese for garnish

Directions

1. In a zip-seal plastic bag, blend together the lemon zest, garlic, lemon juice, porter and olive oil. Add the zucchini strips and let marinate 1 hour.
2. Reserve the marinade for salad. Prepare a grill and grill zucchini until tender, but still holding its shape. Cut into 2-in. chunks, and toss with beans, roasted red peppers, and the remaining marinade in a large bowl.
3. Meanwhile, prepare the pasta according to package directions, or until pasta is tender but still firm (al dente). Drain, place in bowl and stir.
4. Spray a nonstick skillet with cooking oil. Add the chopped herbs and heat until aromatic. Scrape the heated herbs into the pasta mixture and stir to blend. Season with salt and pepper to taste, and serve garnished with grated Romano cheese.

9/21 Heineken

Amsterdam, Holland

Heineken is a 5% abv pale lager made by Heineken International since 1873. It is available in a 4.3% alcohol by volume, in countries such as Ireland. It is the flagship product of the company and is made using purified water, malted barley, hops and yeast. In 1886 H. Elion finished the development of the Heineken A-yeast. This is the yeast that is still used for the beer. The beer is force carbonated. It is the world's most popular lager, and is particularly successful in Europe.

Heineken beer is brewed by 40 breweries in 39 countries around the world

This Week in History - 9/21

Sept 21 On this day in 1780, during the American Revolution, American General Benedict Arnold meets with British Major John Andre to discuss handing over West Point to the British, in return for the promise of a large sum of money and a high position in the British army. The plot was foiled and Arnold, a former American hero, became synonymous with the word "traitor."

Sept 22

On this day in 1862, President Abraham Lincoln issues a preliminary Emancipation Proclamation, which sets a date for the freedom of more than 3 million black slaves in the United States and recasts the Civil War as a fight against slavery.



Sept 23 On this day in 1875, Billy the Kid is arrested for the first time after stealing a basket of laundry. He later broke out of jail and roamed the American West, eventually earning a reputation as an outlaw and murderer and a rap sheet that allegedly included 21 murders.

Sept 24 The Judiciary Act of 1789 is passed by Congress and signed by President George Washington, establishing the Supreme Court of the United States as a tribunal made up of six justices who were to serve on the court until death or retirement

Sept 25 On this day in 1957, under escort from the U.S. Army's 101st Airborne Division, nine black students enter all-white Central High School in Little Rock, Arkansas. Three weeks earlier, Arkansas

Governor Orval Faubus had surrounded the school with National Guard troops to prevent its federal court-ordered racial integration.
